Pursuant to 42 C.F.R. § 447.205, the Georgia Department of Community Health is required to give public notice of any significant proposed change in its methods and standards for setting payment rates for services.

H1N1 INFLUENZA VACCINE ADMINISTRATION REIMBURSEMENT

Effective for dates of services on or after October 6, 2009, and subject to payment at fee-for service rates, the Department of Community Health is proposing to establish the maximum allowable reimbursement for the administration of the H1N1 influenza vaccine to eligible adults over 19 years of age, where the drug is provided free of charge by the federal government, to the lesser of:

- The fee (currently \$8.00) consistent with the vaccine administration rate described for children under the Children's Health Insurance (CHIP) Medicaid Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) programs guideline; or
- The provider's usual and customary charge.

Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids providers subject to this change include but may not be limited to Physicians, Physician Assistants, Nurse Midwives, Advanced Nurse Practitioners, Podiatrists, Oral Maxillofacial Surgeons, and related providers eligible to receive shipment and administer H1N1 influenza vaccine.

The fiscal impact of this change for adult Medicaid is estimated at \$5,159,752 (Total Funds) and \$1,305,933 (State Funds) for SFY 2010.
